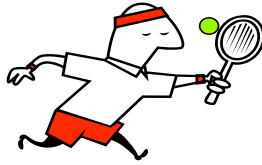

Membership/Contracts/Rates and Fees 2010-2011

As was announced in last month's "Special Edition" newsletter, our membership, contract and court rental rates will be the same next season. While we continue to try and deliver on great programming at a great club, we recognize the tough economy we are in. Bass River Team Round-Up Larry Lebatique, Tennis Director

What an incredible season we are having at Bass River in the various leagues in which we participate. While not all teams are finished at the time of this newsletter, here are some highlights. Both of our junior teams had another great showing in the North Shore League. The girls team finished in 3rd place losing to Westford in the semi-finals. The boys team finished in 2nd

place. In the semi-finals, the boys team defeated Newburyport to reach the finals where they lost to Willows. In the Men's North Shore League, our "A" team finished in 2nd place. They beat Woburn in the semi-finals and faced Westford in the finals. It was a hard fought battle with Bass River just coming short losing 3 – 2. In the ladies North Shore league, our "A" Upper white team won the regular season again. They will face Cedardale in the semi-finals. The "A" Serena team finished in 2nd place and will face Westford in the semi-finals. The "A" Venus team finished in 2nd place and will face Winchester in the semi-finals. In the Working Women's division, both of our teams made the playoffs. Our Working Women's I team finished in 2nd place. They played Northeast in the semi-finals where they lost 2 – 1. The Working Women's II team finished in 1st place to win the league. They played Winchester in the semi-finals where they lost.

In USTA league tennis, we are having another strong showing with teams advancing to sectionals and Nationals. Our mixed USTA 9.0 team is going to sectionals and has a very good chance to get a nationals bid. We had 3 teams here from Bass River that made it to the Nationals. Our 3.5 women's super senior team travelled to Arizona for Nationals. They went 2 – 1 in the round robin just falling short to advance to the next round. Our 4.5 men's super senior team also travelled to Arizona. The team played really hard to advance out of the round robin into the semi-finals. They faced a team from California where they lost to 2 – 1. Last but not least, our 4.0 women's super senior team travelled to Arizona as well for Nationals. In the round robin section, Bass River defeated Missouri Valley, Intermountain-Colorado, and Middle States-Pennsylvania, to go 3 – 0 and advance to the semi-finals. Bass River defeated a team from the Pacific NW in the semis to face Texas in the finals. It was a very tough battle with Bass River being victorious 2 -1 to win the National Championship.

Great job to all of our teams for a very successful season. I would be remiss if I did not mention that every team has one very important common component; the team captain. Each one of our teams has a captain or captains that are responsible for the success of the teams. We are blessed with so many good ones, it is impossible to mention them all. It is often a difficult job, but it does not have to be a thankless one. From me and my staff, "Thank you"! If you play on a team, please remember your captain.

Ladies Team Tryouts

The ladies weekday, North Shore teams will have tryouts on the following schedule...

North Shore A lower (Serena/Venus)	June 2, 3 and 4 (if needed)

North Shore B-1 (All)	June 14, 15

The teams for next season and the tryouts that place those teams will run the same as years past. Please watch the board for sign-ups and make sure you secure a partner for next year. If you need help finding a partner, please talk with any of the Pros. Larry will be keeping a list of those looking and will assist you in finding partners. Remember that the tryouts are not too

far after the end of the league season, so you will need to act quickly if you are planning to go out with a different or new partner. The practice fee for next season will be \$30.00 per coaching session. We feel this is still the best value in the club. Not only do you get a guaranteed 4-to-1 ratio with a Pro, usually a \$34.00 cost, but you have an instructor view your home match and offer a critique of your play at no additional charge.

Summer Junior Tennis Program

Our ***Junior Summer Tennis Program*** will be run out of the Beverly Golf and Tennis Club, 134 McKay Street. Designated programs are rain or shine. Whenever it rains, we move indoors to Bass River! Never miss a class. 1 hour classes meet 3 days a week for beginner to intermediate level players. Daily 3-5 hour programs are available for students looking for a more intensive tennis experience.
